Construction Cost Index (CCI), Road Cost Index (RCI), Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) and Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) in the West Bank* during November,11/2019

Decrease in the Construction Cost Index (CCI) for Residential Buildings

The Construction Cost Index (CCI) for residential buildings reached 105.27 with a decrease of 0.10% in the West Bank* during November 2019 compared with October 2019 (base year 2013=100).

At the level of major groups, the prices of raw materials decreased by 0.20%, while rental of equipment increased by 0.35%. At the same time, labour costs and wages remained stable during November 2019 compared with the previous month.

Slight Decrease in the Construction Cost Index (CCI) for Non-residential Buildings

The Construction Cost Index (CCI) for non-residential buildings reached 105.12 with a slight decrease of 0.09% in the West Bank* during November 2019 compared with October 2019 (base year 2013=100).

At the level of major groups, the prices of raw materials decreased by 0.17%, while rental of equipment increased by 0.31%. At the same time, labour costs and wages remained stable during November 2019 compared with the previous month.

Decrease in the Construction Cost Index (CCI) for Skeleton Buildings

The Construction Cost Index (CCI) for skeleton buildings reached 103.03 with a decrease of 0.17% in the West Bank* during November 2019 compared with October 2019 (base year 2013=100).

At the level of major groups, the prices of raw materials decreased by 0.30%, while rental of equipment increased by 0.34%. At the same time, labour costs and wages remained stable during November 2019 compared with the previous month.

Slight Increase in the Road Cost Index (RCI)

The overall Road Cost Index (RCI) reached 109.17 with a slight increase of 0.04% in the West Bank* during November 2019 compared with October 2019 (base month December 2008=100).

At the level of major groups, operating costs of equipment and maintenance increased by 0.45%, and the prices of raw materials slightly increased by 0.07%, while rental of equipment slightly decreased by 0.08%. At the same time, labour costs and wages remained stable during November 2019 compared with the previous month.

Decrease in the Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI)

The overall Water Networks Cost Index (WNCI) reached 113.08 with a decrease of 0.26% in the West Bank* during November 2019 compared with October 2019 (base month January 2010=100).

Water Reservoirs Cost Index reached 103.82 with a decrease of 0.29%, and Water Networks Cost Index reached 117.29 with a decrease of 0.25% during November 2019 compared with the previous month.

Slight decrease in the Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI)

The overall Sewage Networks Cost Index (SNCI) reached 110.34 with a slight decrease of 0.04% in the West Bank* during November 2019 compared with October 2019 (base month January 2010=100).

2. The differences in the percentage change in major groups of roads, construction, water networks, and sewage networks cost indices is due to the nature compositions of these major groups.
