Increase in the Producer Price¹ Index (PPI) during August, 08/2020

Increase in the Producer Price² Index (PPI) during August 2020

The overall Producer Price Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2018 = 100)reached 93.75 in August 2020, as it increased by 0.69% compared to July 2020.

PPI for locally consumed products

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2018 = 100) reached 93.50 in August 2020, which indicates an increase of 0.79% compared to July 2020.

PPI for local exported products

Producer Price Index for local exported products (2018 = 100) reached 95.98 in August 2020, which indicates a decrease of 0.17% compared to July 2020.

The changes of PPI for August 2020 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Activities	% Change
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	+ 11.57%
Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities	+ 1.23%
Mining and quarrying	+ 0.09%
Agriculture, forestry and fishing goods	- 1.48%
Manufacturing	- 0.01%
