## Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS)

Consumer Prices Continued its Increase within the fourth month respectively as a result of the increase in the prices of fresh chicken, fresh vegetables, fruit, and fuel during April, 04/2022

The overall Consumer Price Index CPI for Palestine during April 2022 **recorded an increase by 1.08%** compared with March 2022 (1.26% in the West Bank\*\*, 0.78% in Jerusalem J1\*, and by 0.72% in Gaza Strip).

The changes in Palestinian CPI for April 2022 were traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Liquid Fuel for Car	
Diesel	+ 5.80%
Petrol	+ 3.28%
Fresh Fruit	+ 3.79%
Fresh meat	+ 1.93%
Dried Vegetables	- 9.03%
Eggs	- 7.33%
Potatoes and other Tubers	- 3.56%

The Palestinian CPI during April 2022 increased by 3.78% compared with April 2021 (4.31% in Jerusalem J1\*, 4.30% in Gaza Strip, and 3.51% in the West Bank\*\*).
