Stability in the consumer price index in Palestine during December, 12/2022

The overall Consumer Price Index CPI for Palestine during December 2022 **recorded a slight increase by 0.01%** compared with November 2022 (0.88% in Jerusalem J1*, and with a slight increase by 0.05% in the West Bank**, while the CPI decreased by 0.69% in Gaza Strip).

The changes in Palestinian CPI during December 2022 were traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with previous month:

Sub Groups	Percent Change
Potatoes	+ 8.27%
Fresh Chicken	+ 6.77%
Liquid Fuel for Car "Petrol"	+ 4.41%
Fresh Vegetables	- 6.13%
Fresh Fruit	- 5.10%
Eggs	- 4.98%
Vegetable Oils	- 2.57%
Dried Vegetables	- 2.13%

The Palestinian CPI during December 2022 increased by 4.09% compared with December 2021 (5.63% in Jerusalem J1*, 4.19% in the West Bank**, and by 2.80% in Gaza Strip).
