#### **Palestinian Consumer Price Index**

## Increase in the CPI during 2015 compared with the previous year

The overall Consumer Price Index (**CPI**) for **Palestine during 2015 increased by 1.43% compared with 2014** (increased by 1.77% in Gaza Strip, 1.29% in the West Bank, and by 0.33% in Jerusalem J1\*).


The change in Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2015 is traced back to changes in prices of the following expenditure sub groups compared with the previous year:


