



An increase in Registered* Exports in Goods in August, 08/2022 compared to the previous month.

Exports in Goods

Exports increased in August, 2022 by 26% compared to July, 2022. It also increased by 12% compared to August, 2021 and reached USD 154.9 Million.

Exports to Israel increased in August, 2022 by 24% compared to July, 2022 and it represented 91% of total exports in August, 2022.

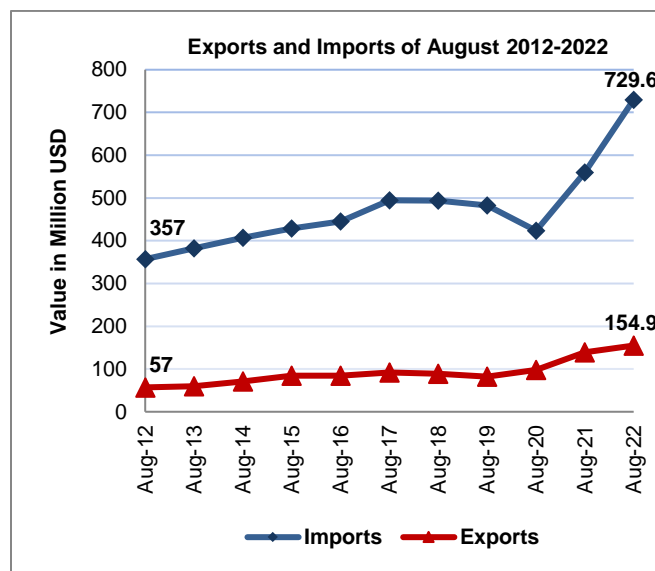
At the same time, exports to other countries increased by 52% during the same period compared to July, 2022.

Imports in Goods

Imports increased in August, 2022 by 7% compared to July, 2022. It also increased by 30% compared to August, 2021 and reached USD 729.6 Million.

Imports from Israel increased by 4% in August, 2022 compared to July, 2022 and it represented 56% of total imports in August, 2022.

At the same time, imports from other countries increased by 10% compared to July, 2022.



Trade Balance on Registered Goods

The trade balance which represents the difference between exports and imports showed an increase in trade deficit by 2% in August, 2022 compared to July, 2022. It also increased by 36% compared to August, 2021 and reached USD 574.7 Million.
