Decrease in the Producer¹ Price Index (PPI) during May, 05/2022

Decrease in the Producer Price Index (PPI) during May 2022

The overall Producer Price Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2019 = 100) reached 103.78 in May 2022, as it decreased by 2.54% compared to April 2022.

PPI for locally consumed products

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2019 = 100) reached 103.26 in May 2022, which indicates a decrease of 2.66% compared to April 2022.

PPI for local exported products

Producer Price Index for local exported products (2019 = 100) reached 108.70 in May 2022, which indicates a decrease of 1.42% compared to April 2022.

The changes of PPI for May 2022 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Activities	% Change
Agriculture, forestry and fishing	- 9.74%
Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities	- 4.09%
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	- 0.21%
Mining and quarrying	0.00%
Manufacturing	+ 0.71%

¹ The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
