



Palestinian Producer¹ Price Index, August 08/2022

Increase in the Producer Price Index (PPI) during August, 08/ 2022

The overall Producer Price Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2019 = 100) reached 105.11 in August 2022, as it increased by 1.68% compared to July 2022.

PPI for locally consumed products

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2019 = 100) reached 104.75 in August 2022, which indicates an increase of 1.78% compared to July 2022.

PPI for local exported products

Producer Price Index for local exported products (2019 = 100) reached 108.47 in August 2022, which indicates an increase of 0.76% compared to July 2022.

The changes of PPI for August 2022 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Activities	% Change
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	+ 6.65%
Agriculture, forestry and fishing	+ 4.16%
Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities	+ 4.16%
Mining and quarrying	+ 1.19%
Manufacturing	- 0.12%

¹ The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
