### **Palestinian Producer<sup>1</sup> Price Index**

## Increase in the Producer Price Index (PPI) during September, 09/2022

The overall Producer Price Index (PPI) for Palestine with its base year (2019 = 100) reached 106.98 in September 2022, as it increased by 1.78% compared to August 2022.

### **PPI** for locally consumed products

Producer Price Index for locally consumed products (2019 = 100) reached 106.80 in September 2022, which indicates an increase of 1.95% compared to August 2022.

#### PPI for local exported products

Producer Price Index for local exported products (2019 = 100) reached 108.70 in September 2022, which indicates an increase of 0.21% compared to August 2022.

The changes of PPI for September 2022 were traced back to changes in prices of the following major activities compared to the previous month:

Major Activities	% Change
Agriculture, forestry and fishing	+ 5.34%
Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply	+ 3.74%
Mining and quarrying	+ 0.12%
Manufacturing	+ 0.10%
Water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities	- 3.31%

The producer's prices exclude any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.
