# The Annual Report on Transportation and Communication Statistics in the Palestinian Territory, 2011

#### **Main Results:**

## An Increase in Numbers of Workers in the Transport, Storage and Communication Activity

The report results showed that the percentage of total number of workers in the transport, storage and communication Activity in 2011 increased by 6.0 of total workers in the Palestinian Territory.

#### Number of licensed vehicles in the West Bank\*

The results show that the total number of licensed vehicles in the West Bank was 138,644 at the end of 2011 with an increase by 1.7 percent as compared to 2010.

The data showed that the private cars formed 72.4 percent of the total vehicles in the West Bank.

### An Increase of the Road Accidents and Casualties in the West Bank\*

The results of the annual report showed that the number of registered road accidents in the West Bank reached 7,406 in 2011, with an increase by 36.9 percent in comparison to 2010. The number of casualties in 2011 was 7,970 with an increase by 13.3 percent in comparison to 2010. Those slightly injured formed 86.0 percent out of the total injured persons and the rate of fatally injured formed 1.5 percent compared to 1.9 percent fatally injured in 2010.

#### **An Increase in Number of Main Telephone Lines in the Palestinian Territory**

The results showed that the total main telephone lines operating in the Palestinian Territory was 382,700 lines by the end of 2011, with an increase by 6.2 percent as compared to 2010.

### Number of subscribers Cellular phone in the Palestinian Territory

The results indicated that the number of subscribers in the Palestinian Cellular Phones by the end of the year 2011 in the Palestinian Territory was 2.9 million subscribers with a growth rate of 10.8 percent in compared with 2010.
