The Violence survey on the Palestinian society, 2011 was planned and implemented by a technical team from the PCBS and national committee of government institutions and non-governmental.

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Chapter one

Objectives and Methodology of the Survey and Sample

PCBS has executed a specialized national survey regarding violence in the Palestinian society with financial and technical cooperation between MDG-F / UNDP/ PAPP, UNICEF and UNFPA. This survey is the second of its kind to be executed nationwide to study this phenomenon that inside and outside individuals of households are subject to, during the year 2011. The survey was implemented on a household sample totaled 5,811 households in the Palestinian territory through the third quarter of year 2011 for the purpose of providing data of comprehensive and representative statistics about violence in the Palestinian territories mainly against women, youth, children, elderly and male spouses.

1. Objectives of the Survey:

The survey is aiming at:

1. Providing an updated data base about the phenomenon of violence against individuals inside the Palestinian society whether they were women who were previously married or spouses or single individuals (males or females) or children and elderly.
2. Recognizing the form and size of violence that faces youth in Palestinian society .
3. Demographic and economical particularities of individuals exposed to violence, whether this individual is the spouse or a member of the household.
4. Assisting planers and policy makers designing strategies and policies that will contribute to the reduction of violence inside the Palestinian society.
5. Provide feedback to the institutions of civil society in the quality and class of the service offered to the victims of violence.
6. Recognizing other types and forms of violence against women and children by individuals out of the household.
7. Recognizing other types of violence that is practiced against women and individuals by the occupation forces and settlers .

2. Designing of survey questionnaire:

1. At the start to develop the survey questionnaire, the international recommendations and the experiences of other countries on violence were reviewed, taking into account the singularity of the Palestinian society during the implementation of the survey. The questionnaire of the survey was designed depending on the first experience of PCBS in carrying out violence survey of 2005/2006. Moreover the questionnaire got developed in the second survey with the cooperation of our partners in the National Committee of violence survey and the advisor of the survey. Numerous perceptions of the experts, that represent the Palestinian experience in this field and the extent of the local society need for such indicators, were adopted.

2. The questionnaire included the classification questions that are included in all questionnaires such as education, age, work status and marital status which has usually been inserted in most surveys and household survey. Furthermore; a questionnaire related to household was designed to measure life quality and the availability of durable goods and recognizing economic status of the household.
3. Five sections were designed for the questionnaire: the first one was designed for women who were Ever married within the age group of (18-64), the second was designed for spouses, the third one was designed for never married individuals aged (18-64) years, the fourth was designed for children (12-17 years) and the fifth and the last section was designed for the elderly (65) years of age and over.

Please note the following:

- Rates of violence displayed in the report represent those who were exposed to violence (at least one time) according to the form of violence that has been measured in the survey questionnaire.
- All target groups in the survey, except spouses, were interviewed directly (not proxy). Therefore, the data presented in the report reflects the responses of the interviewees themselves.
- With respect to husband section, wives were interviewed on behalf of their husbands, and they were asked whether they have acted against their husbands, then the percentage of wives who have acted against their husbands were calculated according to the operational definition used in the survey depending on the responses of wives.

3. Data collection:

The field work team in the West Bank compounded of 4 field work coordinators, 78 female field workers, 15 male fieldworkers, 15 female supervisor and 9 auditors. For Gaza Strip, the field work team compounded of one coordinator, 49 female fieldworkers, 6 male fieldworkers, 6 female supervisor and 5 auditors. Data collecting from the field in the West Bank was initiated on 03/07/2011 and was finished on 30/07/2011. While in the Gaza Strip, collecting data process started on 10/07/2011 and was finished on 30/07/2011.

4. Sample Frame:

Sample frame was composed of enumeration areas that were defined in the population, housing, and establishment census - 2007 and they were close in size geographic areas where the number of households was 14 household and enumeration areas were used as primary sampling units.

Sampling Design:

The sample is a cluster strata sample (pps) of two stages:

The first stage: A cluster random probability sample that is proportional to the size of each enumeration area of households (pps) composed of (190) enumeration areas were selected.

The second stage: 30 households were selected, from each enumeration area that was selected in the first stage, in systematic random way.

The third stage: One individual of each selected household was selected according to the targeted group by using Kish Tables in the process of selecting the individual from the household in order to guarantee random for children, youth and women groups.

Sample Stratums:

The society was stratified in to stratums as follows:

1. The governorate (16) governorates.
2. Type of localities (urban, rural and refugee camp).

Sample size:

The size of the survey sample was 5,811 households distributed by 3,891 households in the West Bank and 1,920 in Gaza Strip.

5. Response rates:

The number of completed households were 5,118 of which 3,421 households in the West Bank and 1,767 in Gaza Strip. Weights were modified according to the design stratum for modifying the effect of denial rates and no responding. Response rate in the West Bank was 92.2% while in Gaza Strip it was 94.9%. The following table shows the response rate by targeted group.

Chapter two

Main Findings

1- Occupation violence

About half of the Palestinian households were directly exposed to violence by occupation forces/settlers before July/ 2010, the highest in Gaza Strip it was 49.1% compared to 47.8% in the West Bank. On the other hand this percentage was the highest in Qalqiliya governorate; 60.0%.

The youth males are the most subjected group to occupation and settlers violence:

About 6% of youths of the age 18-29 years were exposed to psychological violence by occupation forces and settlers during the period of 12 months before July/2011; about 10% among males and 1.4% among females.

About 2 children out of 100 aged 12-17 were exposed to physical violence by the occupation forces.

About 3% of male children were exposed to physical violence from the occupation forces during the period of 12 months before July/2011 among them 5% in the West Bank compared to 0.3% in Gaza Strip this percent was 0.4% among females, 0.7% in the West Bank while, no case were reported about females physical violence by the occupation in Gaza Strip due to the absence of direct contacts with occupation forces over there .

About 4 children out of 100 aged 12-17 years were exposed to psychological violence of the occupation forces.

About 6% of male children exposed to psychological violence of the occupation forces and settlers during the period of 12 months before July/2011. 8.7% were in the West Bank compared to 0.8% in Gaza Strip, this percent was 1.2%. 1.7% among females in the West Bank compared to 0.4% in Gaza Strip.

Occupation Checkpoints are a source for violence against youths

8.0% of youths aged 18-29 years were exposed to psychological violence at checkpoints of the occupation, 13.4% were males compared to 2.3% were females. while 8.0% of males youths of the same age group exposed to physical violence at the occupation checkpoints, and about 1% of the females were exposed to the same type of violence.

Psychological violence against women at occupation checkpoints

3.3% of the women who ever been married was exposed to psychological violence at the occupation checkpoints by occupation soldiers, 0.6% of them were exposed to physical violence and 0.2% were exposed to sexual violence “ sexual harassment” .

2- Public Sphere Violence

Street is the most place where youths and women are exposed to violence

About 20% of youths aged 18-29 years were exposed to psychological violence in the street, 28.7% were males compared to 10.2% of the females. 8.4% of youths were exposed physical violence in the street, 15.8% were males compared to 0.6% of the females in the street .while 1.7% of youth were exposed to sexual violence “ sexual harassment “in the street , 0.5% were males compared to 3.0% females . the results indicate that about 5% of women who previously married were subjected to psychological violence in the street by other individuals ,and 1.3% were subjected to sexual violence “ sexual harassment “ while 0.6 % of women were subjected to physical violence .

Violence against youths outside the household

14.3% of youths have been subject to psychological violence from strange man, and 9.1% were exposed to modest physical violence by same source, while around 6% of youths were exposed to modest physical violence by a Palestinian security man, and 5.4% were exposed to psychological violence by same source.

Educational institutions one of the places where youth and children were exposed to violence

About 9% of youths 18-29 years were exposed to psychological violence at the educational institutions; 4.2% had been exposed to physical violence in these educational institutions; 6.7% of which were males compared to 1.5% females.

More than one fifth of the student’s age 12-17 years were exposed to psychological violence at schools , out of the students who attended schools during the period of 12 months that preceded the July / 2011; 21.6% in West Bank compared to 22.7% in Gaza Strip. The results indicated that, psychological violence was the most practiced violence against these students by their colleagues or teachers, 25.0% and 27.6% respectively. On the other hand the rate of those who were exposed to physical violence by their teachers was 21.4% compared to 14.2% by their fellow students.

Women were exposed to psychological violence at public service locations

4.0% of women who were ever married were exposed to psychological violence by service providers and other individuals present at such places, while receiving health, social, and cultural services at the locations where such services are provided.

3- Violence inside the household

More of psychological violence against women by their husbands

About 37% of women who ever been married were exposed to one form of violence by their husbands; 29.9% in the West Bank compared to 51.1% in Gaza Strip. The rate of those who were exposed to psychological violence “at least for one time” among those women out of violated women was 58.6%. 55.1% were exposed to economical violence, 54.8% were exposed to social violence, 23.5% were exposed to physical violence and 11.8% were exposed to sexual violence.

Two third of women who were exposed to violence prefer silence and refuge to household as a second choice :

30.2% of exposed women who were ever married and were exposed to violence by their husbands have had recourse to the house of one of the brothers or sisters and 65.3% preferred to remain silent regarding the act of violence that were practiced against them by their husbands, while the rate of women who have been exposed to violence and headed to a women institution or center soliciting advise did not exceed 0.7%.

Parents are the first to practice violence against children .

51.0% of children were exposed to violence inside the household by one individual member of the household; 45.8% in West Bank compared to 59.4% in Gaza Strip; 69.0% of them were exposed to psychological violence by their parents, and 34.4% to physical violence compared to 66.3% of these children were exposed to psychological violence and 34.5% to physical violence by their mothers.

Elderly females more exposed to violence than males

7.3% of the elderly 65 years and over were exposed to one form of violence by one individual of the household, 8.5% in the west bank compared to 4.5% in the Gaza strip the percentage among males was 6.4% compared to 7.9% females.

Based on the forms of violence that were measured in the survey questionnaire, it became clear that health negligence was the most form of violence that the elderly are exposed to, 17.1%; 18.3% among females compared to 15.5% among males. 11.4% of these individuals were exposed to a psychological violence, 13.2% females compared to 9.3% males.

17% of women indicated that they practice violence against their husbands

The wife has been asked if she had practiced any form of violence against the husband during the period of 12 months before July /2011, it was found that 17.1% of women indicated that they practice violence against their husbands; 13.3% in the West Bank compared to 24.1% in Gaza Strip; 35.1% of them were exposed to psychological violence, 20.2% were exposed to physical violence, 4.5% were exposed to social violence and 4.9% were exposed to economical violence.

Concepts and Definitions

- Domestic violence:** Violence is any act or failure to act of a household member against another member in the household for the purpose of causing physical, sexual or psychological abuse, or the threat of physical, sexual or psychological abuse, or generates fear. It also includes the deprivation of basic rights such as shelter, food, drink, clothing, education, freedom of movement and loss of self-determination and self security.
- Women:** The term women, refers to all ages of females regardless of their social, legal status, race, religion, class or any other factor.
- Violence against women:** All forms of behaviors or actions taken against woman causing a physical, psychological, sexual, verbal abuse and social and economic deprivation, it also includes the threat of doing such acts and all sorts of coercion and deprivation of liberty all because they are females, whether directly or indirectly, and that causes damage or pain physically, sexually, mentally, socially or economically, whether it happened in public or private life.
- Physical violence:** A behavior directed against the body. Physical violence is practiced through punching, hair-pulling, arm-twisting, pinching, slapping, kicking, strangling, scorching, pulling, dragging, killing, and beating. It is used to express physical power. The victim of physical violence is usually the weaker person.
- Psychological violence:** It is a type of violence reflected in a psychological behavior or bad treatment, disdain, and despise of people. It is done through the use of cursing and insults by the person who practiced violence., breaking things that belong to the person, shouting and yelling at, name-calling, mocking using demeaning names, forcing to do specific acts, throwing out of the house, locking up in the house, terrorization, continuous threatening, and forcing. Psychological violence is used to cause anxiety fear, psychological damage, degrading, making one feel negative, weaken physical and mental capacities, harming other people and destroy capabilities, shaking self-confidence, undermining self-respect,. Psychological violence destroys self-confidence, causes body harm, loss of self-confidence.
- Sexual Violence:** An act of using various aggressive Actions for the purpose of sexual abuse and causing harm. Sexual violence is done through sexual harassment, rape, husband's refusal to use contraceptives during sexual intercourse with his wife, using physical force to compel the wife to have sexual intercourse, threatening to use sharp tools and beating to force her to have sexual intercourse, and using violent and harmful means. The purpose of this type of violence is to abuse the victim and use force to control the victim who is usually the woman; it occurs because there aren't any strict rules taken against the perpetrators.

- Economic violence against the wife** It is a type of violence, wife exposed to violence from husband and takes several forms, including demand from the individual to know how to spend the money, dispose of property of others, prevention of work, dispose of inheritance without the consent of the person who received the inheritance, forced to resign.
- Less severe physical violence** It includes punching, beating, pushing, pulling hair, or attracted you of your clothes. The leaves traces of physical violence on the body.
- More severe physical violence** It includes strangulation, Hriqk intentionally, threat, use a gun or a knife or other weapon toward you, attack you body harmless, such as a chair and a stick, rod iron belt or the like, may leave physical violence effects on the body.
- Political violence:** It is the violence of the state done through the practices addressed by the state or the political system or political organizations. It is the lack of respect for human rights, which is practiced by using barriers and detentions, all forms of oppression, all forms of violence, physical and psychological violence, war, repression of liberties, confiscating the land, and the suppression of the citizens, done by one State against another State. Political violence used by the aggressor enemy to cause abuse, and the victims are citizens , individuals and groups, and such actions happened due to contradictions in point of views, or political party membership, that leaves physical and psychological abuses.
- Social violence:** All actions practiced by family or society which prohibit women from acquiring their rights and freedoms due to the social and cultural heritage.
- Sexual harassment:** A form of sexual violence which relates to sexual behaviors, either verbal or physical, or in the form of suggestions intended to infringement another party, or affects it.
- Rape:** Any person forces another to have sex with without consent regardless to the gender.
- Verbal abuse:** Using terms and words that degrade the dignity of the individual and lead to the destruction of self-confidence and feeling humiliated.
- Threat:** Form of violence, which is defined as any behavior or suggestion through tone of voice or looks or signals exercised by the aggressor, or through the use of the aggressor of violence and physical force which results in the sense of insecurity for both males or females, and this is accompanied with the feeling of lack of dignity, humiliation and powerlessness.

- Child:** Every human being under the age of eighteen.
- Violence between spouses:** It includes all forms of violence, whether sexual or psychological or physical or it could be a deprivation of social, economic and political rights which is practiced by one spouse to the other.
- Marital rape:** Forcing the wife to have sexual intercourse at an inappropriate times or in times of illness or to force the wife to do humiliating sexual acts during intercourse or forcing her to comply with his demands and unnatural practices.
- Social Abuse against the elderly** This is a type of abuse that elderly people (65 and over) are exposed to by a household member whom they reside or do not reside with. It takes different forms including; force them to stay in bed pretending that they are sick even though they are not sick, or any member of their family isolate them from people or prevent them from meeting any one.
- Physical Abuse against the elderly** This is a type of abuse that elderly people (65 and over) are exposed to by a household member whom they reside or do not reside with. It takes different forms including causing bodily harm, arm twisting or pulling, causing joints pain or bruises or scratches and little wounds caused by attacks, loss of consciousness resulting from head-beating, beating with a built or stick and breaking a bone as a result of an attack.
- Economic Abuse against the elderly** This is a type of abuse that elderly people (65 and over) are exposed to by a household member whom they reside or do not reside with. It takes different forms including taking things belonging to the elderly such as (money, property, and the like), also, breaking things that belong to elderly people.
- Health Ignorance** This is a type of abuse that elderly people (65 and over) are exposed to by a household member whom they reside or do not reside with. It takes different forms including cannot take their medicine by their delves or family members do not assist them to take their medicine when needs.
- households who exposed to violence from Israeli occupation forces and settlers** Is a form of violence against the husband or wife or children, whether they are males or females or any family members by occupation or settlers and it includes several forms, martyrdom, injury, beatings, arrests, raids, demolitions of a family members.
- Aggressor \ ranter:** Any person who practices violence in all its forms.
